Starting before October 2023 in Laboratoire de mathématiques d'Orsay – Université Paris-Saclay. (ANR project GeMfaceT)

The position is funded by the ANR project *A bridge between Geometric Measure and Discrete Surface Theories* (GeMfaceT).

Main research topics

The candidate is expected to have expertise in at least some of the following areas: calculus of variations, geometric measure theory, surface modelling, geometric inference, geometry processing, interactions of applied analysis and geometry. Experience in programming will be valued though not mandatory.

Practical information

- The postdoc position is full-time for 2 years.
- Salary will be adjusted to the experience accordingly to Paris-Saclay salaries grid.
- No compulsory teaching duty.
- The starting date must be no later than October 2023.
- Scientific environment: the postdoc will be part of the Harmonic analysis team of Orsay and depending on his/her interests, interactions with the INRIA DataShape team as well as the ANEDP team are natural.
